Why do you think people today have a hard time seeking guidance from the Lord?

Read Acts 20:22-24

- Share one verse or phrase from the passage above that stands out to you. What puzzles you, resonates with you, or is something that intrigues you?
- What does it mean to be dependent on the Spirit? What does that look like in our everyday lives?
- In what kinds of areas, actions, or decisions do you typically seek guidance? Any other areas where you should be seeking guidance?
- Often fear and pride can get in the way of hearing from God. Do we even want to know what God thinks? Can we fully trust Him? Do we need His direction? Which of these questions do you struggle with the most?
- In verses 22 and 23, why do you think God allowed there to be resistance in Paul's ministry? Why does He allow it in our lives?
- Be honest - when we seek guidance from God, what is our motivation? If we have not already done so, how can we align our priorities with God's?

NEXT STEPS

The soundtrack of guidance! Getting guidance from the Lord may look different for each of us. Yet, each of us needs to be dependent on the Spirit, humble, ready for resistance, and aligned with God's priorities. In which one of these areas can you take a next step this week?
